Dear Ms Salvo,

After I talked with you, I looked in a closet and found those cells that I thought I had left in Basking Ridge. I have tested several and selected two that I am sure I will never miss. They are not quite the best I ever made ~~and~~ a lot better than the worst. These particular cells develop about a third of a volt on open circuit in full sunlight. The current on short circuit is about <sup>30</sup> milli-amps.

I have made a real effort to pack them for reasonable protection and to make a small package that I can put in an envelope. Because the letter is now a little thick, I put on two stamps which I think covers this condition. This saves me a trip to the Post Office which ~~may~~ might be delayed several days.

Maybe you could let me know if these get through O.K. Or I can just assume they do if the letter is not returned to sender.
